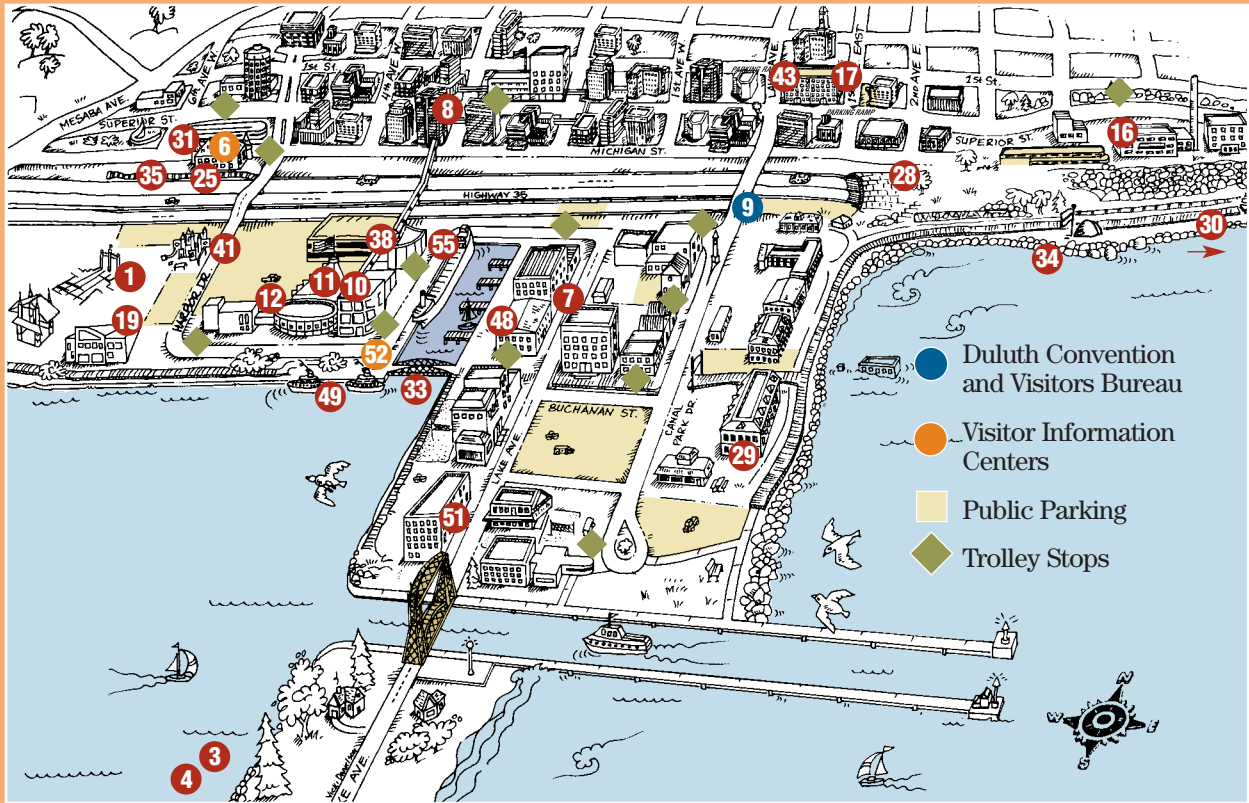


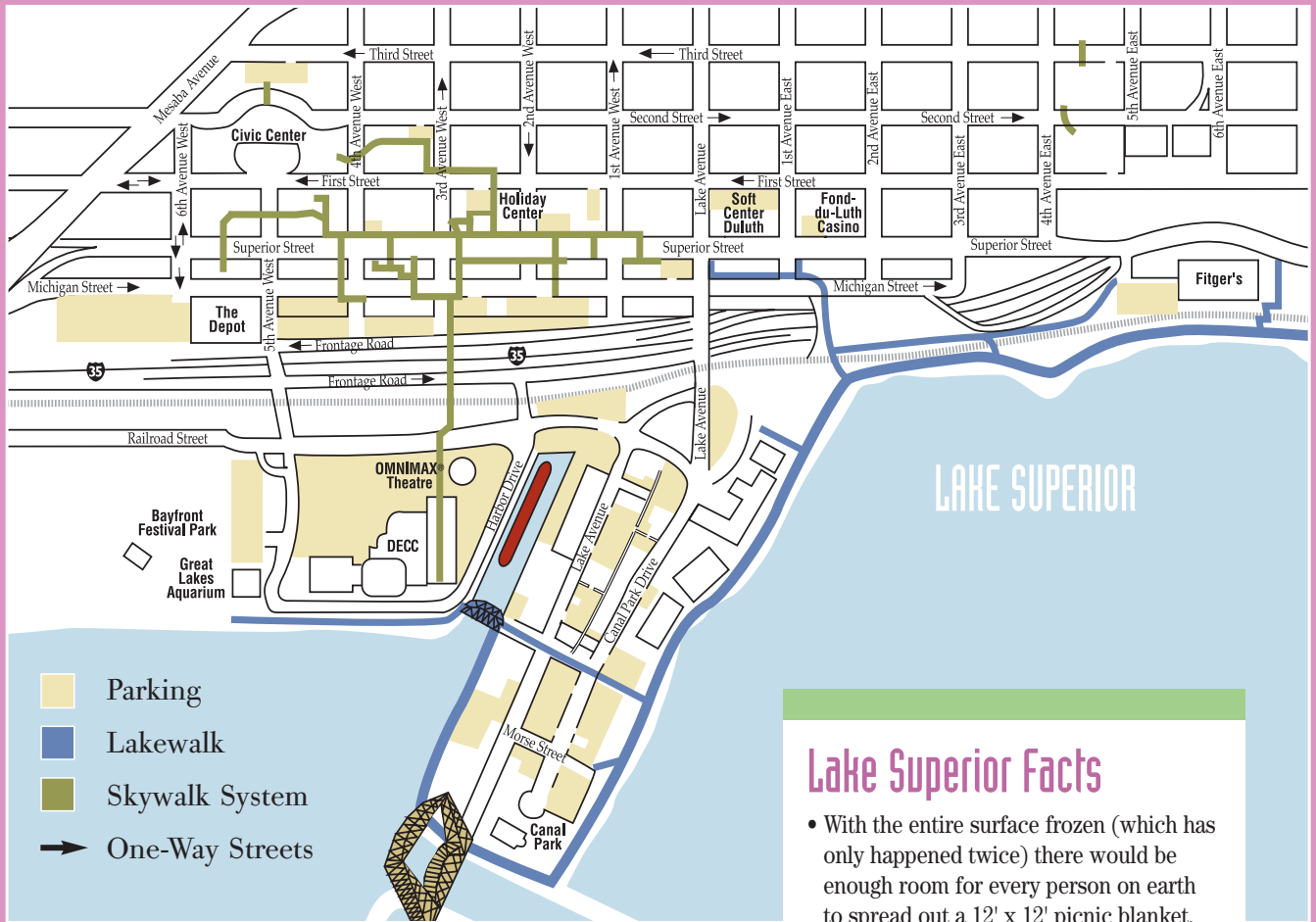
downtown & canal park area map
